- 1.** Baron d'Arignac Dry White 2008, France **£14.95**  
Fresh and vibrant on the nose with a fruit packed palate of citrus and apple.
- 2.** Candidato Viura 2008, Spain **£15.95**  
On the nose there are fruity notes of green apples, grapefruit and quince. Silky and smooth on the palate with well-balanced flavours and a long finish.
- 3.** Ruitersvlei Chenin Blanc 2008, South Africa **£16.95**  
A beautifully soft and juicy wine with aromas of pear and stoned fruit moving to a fresh and delicate palate.
- 4.** Siete Soles Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2008, Chile **£17.50**  
Ripe lime and gooseberry on the nose with a super juicy, clean and refreshing palate.
- 5.** Picpoul de Pinet Beauvigac 2008, Languedoc, France **£18.95**  
Aromatic and subtle, showing stoned fruit on the nose. The palate is clean and fresh with flavours of lemon, apple and peach.
- 6.** Yalumba 'Y' Series Unwooded Chardonnay 2007, Australia **£19.50**  
Classic Ozzy Chardonnay, without the oak. Bursting with apple and yellow fruit.
- 7.** Cheverny Domaine des Marnieres 2008, Loire, France **£25.95**  
A stones throw from Sancerre and loads of bang for your buck! Clean, refreshing and elegant with full Sauvignon character.
- 8.** Chablis Domaine Jean-Marc Brocard 2007, Burgundy, France **£29.95**  
Clear, bright and fresh, everything you want from a top class Chablis. The palate has crisp green fruit, a wonderful mouth-feel and exceptional balance and versatility.

- 9.** Baron D'Arignac Rose 2007, France **£14.95**  
Vibrant pink in colour with lifted aromas of red berry fruit and a soft, subtle palate.
- 10.** Mannara Pinot Grigio Rose 2008, Italy **£16.95**  
A fresh, elegant rosé with fruity, floral aromas and a palate dominated by melon and strawberries. Lush!

## **Reds**

- 11. Baron D'Arignac Red 2007, France** **£14.95**  
Cheeky little French biddy with juicy red and black fruit aromas and a medium-light bodied palate.
- 12. Siete Soles Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2007, Chile** **£16.50**  
A belter of a Chilean Cab! Super juicy aromas of cassis and dark fruit move to a silky soft palate with spice and creamy vanillin oak.
- 13. Gran Hacienda Carmenere 2008, Chile** **£18.50**  
Bursting with aromas of dark fruit, spice and meaty characters move to a sensationally juicy and robust palate. Carmenere the way it should be!
- 14. Finca La Colonia Malbec, Bodegas Norton 2008, Argentina** **£19.95**  
Sweet and spicy aromas of juicy fruit and black pepper. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish. Lush.
- 15. Castel Firmian Merlot, Mezzacorona 2007, Italy** **£20.95**  
Intense fragrance with a mixture of ripe fruits and a hint of oak. Dry, complex and well-structured palate. A stunning wine from a brilliant producer.
- 16. Goldridge Pinot Noir 2006, New Zealand** **£23.95**  
Cracking Kiwi Pinot here with a smooth nose of cherry and raspberry moving to a delicate palate of red fruit and subtle spicy oak. An elegant and warming wine with a soft and lingering finish.
- 17. Conde de Valdemar Rioja Crianza 2005, Spain** **£26.50**  
Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with aromatic complexity lasting through to the finish.
- 18. Chateau La Haut Claymore, Lussac St Emilion 2005, France** **£28.95**  
A stunning, Merlot dominant, Bordeaux blend. Beautifully balanced aromas of plum and dark fruit mix with spice and oak. The palate is delightfully rich and smooth with an elegant finish.

## **Sparkling & Champagne**

- 19.** Rene Barbier Brut Reserva Cava, Spain **£14.95**  
A sumptuous and elegant Cava, with clean citrus on the nose, backed up by soft fruit aromas of peach and melon. Yumm.
- 20.** Itynera Prosecco NV Brut, Italy **£5.00 glass 125ml / £18.50**  
Juicy, fruity and stylish fizzy with full aromas of pear and peach leading to a soft and bubbly palate!
- 21.** Testulat Carte d'Or Brut Blanc de Noirs NV, France **£31.00**  
Rich, fruity champagne with notes of vanilla and peaches. Elegant and well-balanced.
- 22.** Joseph Perrier Cuvee Royal Brut NV, France **£39.95**  
One of the best Grand Marques from Champagne. Beautiful nose of fresh apple and lemon move to a slightly biscuity and awesome palate.
- Half Bottles 375mls **£22.50**      Quarters 200mls **£12.50**
- 23.** Joseph Perrier Brut Rose NV, France **£50.00**  
A sensational rose Champagne! Clean, crisp and pure aromas of strawberry and red fruit with touches of short-cake. The palate is refreshing and unashamedly decadent!
- 24.** Bollinger Special Cuvee NV, France **£57.00**  
Probably the most famous Champagne in the world! Beautiful biscuity nose with rich fruit and cream. The palate is full and toasty with great length. It's also Lynsey's favourite so you can't go wrong!

## **Sweeties and Port**

- 25.** Brown Brothers Orange Muscat & Flora 2008, Australia **£3.50 50ml/£14.95 Btl**  
Made from the lesser known grapes Orange Muscat and Flora, a cross between Semillon and Gewürztraminer, the wine has marmalade and apricot with a refreshing citrus tang. Beautifully light and lively with a clean, fresh finish.
- 26.** Dindarello Maculan 2007, Italy **£5.00 50ml**  
An intense nose of Muscat grapes, honey and flowers leads to a vibrant palate, with the sweetness balanced by freshness of flavour and a delicate mouthfeel. Very Moreish!
- 27.** Warres Otima 10 Y.O. Tawny Port **£4.95 50ml**  
A cracking Tawny port from one of the best producers. Aromas of raisins and orange peel with a light, delicate palate giving great versatility. Enjoy slightly chilled as drunk in Portugal.
- 28.** Grahams L.B.V Port 2003 **£5.95 50ml/£35.00Btl**  
A wine of a single vintage bottled at least 4 years in cask, the LBV is unfiltered and only lightly fined in order to retain the natural balance of the wine and reflects the rich, concentrated flavours characteristic of all Graham's ports. Undoubtedly one of the best L.B.V's available.
- 29.** Grahams Quinta Dos Malvedos Vintage Port 1998 **£6.95 50ml**  
Providing the base for all Graham's vintage ports, even in undeclared years the wine is still of sufficient quality to be bottled on its own. The 'Malvedos' never fails to deliver, full-on Christmas cake in a bottle!
